



- Students major in History as undergraduates ;
- Students submit an application to SLU Law In their third year as an undergraduate;
- Students meet all undergraduate core curriculum and major requirements;
- Students admitted to SLU Law begin their JD program in their fourth year;
- Students' first year of law school coursework also counts as elective credit toward the undergraduate bachelor's degree.

Here are the details:

Students majoring in History are eligible to participate with the study of law, this accelerated pathway allows students to complete their undergraduate degree in 3 years. Students must complete at least 75% of their undergraduate coursework before matriculation necessary to enter the law school. Students must meet College core curriculum requirements and History major
