



Tuition Exchange Frequently Asked Questions Prospective Saint Louis University Students

Q. Who is eligible for Tuition Exchange Scholarships at Saint Louis University?

A. You are eligible if you are currently attending a high school or college in the United States and you are a member of the National Exchange Student Organization (NESO). A. Usually there are between 60 and 120 TE awards available each year. However, the number of awards is determined by the number of students who apply.

Q. How is TE determined?
